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Préambule

Les mots, comme les idées, apparaissent et se diffusent parfois de manière autonome, comme s'ils étaient vivants. Dans la société de l'information qu'est la nôtre, des milliards de mots transitent chaque seconde, des émetteurs aux récepteurs, des organismes aux machines et vice-versa. Nous sommes au milieu des ordinateurs, nous envoyons chaque jour des mots dans le réseau et en recevons de lui. Sans nécessairement nous en rendre compte, nous échangeons sans cesse avec et à travers les bots. Ces programmes, soutenus par une structure mondialisée d'ordinateurs interconnectés, publient inlassablement sur les réseaux sociaux et les plateformes participatives. Ils prennent part aux discussions sur les forums, publient des articles, s'insèrent dans nos conversations de groupe et s'adressent à nous lorsque nous visitons des sites web avec l'espoir de capter notre attention et d'interpréter nos attitudes pour mieux en extraire le potentiel marchand.

Ces constructions artificielles miment nos manières organiques d'être au monde pour mieux s'intégrer à ces dernières et mieux les détourner dans des perspectives commerciales. Ne nous y trompons pas : leur intelligence artificielle, située au plus profond des CPU, n'interprète pas, ne lit pas, n'écrit pas et ne parle pas non plus : elle calcule. Si les échanges dont nous faisons l'expérience avec les grands modèles de langage (LLM) tels que ChatGPT, Llama3 ou encore Deepseek revêtent l'apparence d'une humanité créative, ils ne sont que le produit statistique des échanges que nous avons déjà eus à travers nos ordinateurs, téléphones et autres transcripteurs. Autant d'appareils, de techniques et de protocoles qui, déjà, ont formaté nos façons de parler, d'écrire, de lire et de raconter. Le format court du SMS a mené à l'émergence d'un langage compressé dans lequel chaque signe est pesé. Avec les LLM, la langue est remaniée, devient un assemblage de jetons, des *tokens* avec leur poids, leur taille et leur capacité à activer des neurones, artificiels eux aussi.

Les processus en jeu dans les LLM – la mesure des valeurs des poids, l'activation des neurones, la mémorisation des processus passés et autres méthodes mathématiques de pondération des ensembles de caractères et de circonscription de jetons – ne s'avèrent pas infaillibles et échappent parfois aux règles imposées. La température est quelquefois élevée, le cerveau chauffe artificiellement jusqu'à délirer et halluciner. Occasionnellement, ces hallucinations semblent détenir un potentiel créatif qui, à la manière d'un surréaliste échauffé, ouvre la voie à des surprises conceptuelles et des interprétations humaines nouvelles. Une imagination artificielle (i) chère aux artistes, même si les « idées » ainsi nées ne sont pas toujours intéressantes à un lecteur humain.

Il arrive que ces hallucinations soient transmises non pas à un humain, mais à un autre modèle de *machine learning*. Transférées d'un modèle à un autre, d'un *bot* à un autre, il arrive même que ces hallucinations intègrent des bases de données qui alimentent à leur tour d'autres modèles pour, finalement, être normalisées et transformées en représentations tout à fait banales, de sorte qu'elles deviennent un *token* comme un autre dans le monde obscur des LLM. C'est le cas d'un mot en particulier, dont le présent ouvrage s'attache à explorer les contours : *arafed*.

Le terme « *arafed* » ne renvoie à rien de connu dans la langue anglaise, ni même dans une autre langue, bien qu'il semble que le mot *araf* ait une existence en gallois ^[2]. Mais si le terme *arafed* est ici écrit sans qu'il soit présent dans aucun dictionnaire connu, c'est bien qu'il a été découvert. Par qui ? Difficile à dire, mais c'est dans une conférence menée par Léon-Étienne Kühr et Ting-Chun Liu ^[3] qu'il a été porté à mon attention. Au cours de leur présentation, les deux chercheurs exposent l'existence de ce terme dans de multiples contextes sur le réseau Internet et remontent à son origine. Celle-ci, expliquent-ils, se loge dans les couches successives qui jalonnent l'évolution des recherches en *machine learning* et, surtout, dans la succession des monopoles logiciels qui ont forgé ces évolutions.

C'est BLIP^[4], un modèle de génération de légendes d'images, qui aurait, le premier, fait apparaître le mot *arafed* en se basant sur l'ensemble de données (*dataset*) constitué d'images légendées qu'est COCO^[5]. Utilisé massivement parce qu'accessible facilement dès 2014, COCO contient des textes en anglais qui décrivent des images et qui commencent, dans la très très grande majorité des cas, par « A » ou « An » : *An apple on a table, a plate full of food that is sitting on a table, a brown teddy bear with a blue bib on that says baby*. D'après Kühr et Liu, la surreprésentation de cet article indéfini a mené le modèle BLIP à produire trois *tokens*, à leur tour surreprésentés dans ses productions : a, ##raf et ##ed. Les symboles « dièses » qui précèdent les *tokens* ainsi produits indiquent, dans le modèle, que la suite de lettres doit être impérativement précédée par une autre suite de lettres sans espaces.

Ayant ainsi enregistré qu'une phrase commence généralement par le *token* « a » et que les deux autres *tokens* suivent généralement cette lettre, les légendes produites par BLIP débutent alors assez souvent par le terme *arafed*. Kühr et Liu poursuivent et expliquent que la présence importante de monopoles dans l'accessibilité restreinte des outils de *machine learning* exacerbe la diffusion du mot *arafed*. Les résultats générés par l'utilisation de BLIP viennent nourrir de nouveaux modèles qui, étant *open source*, sont utilisés dans les recherches et produisent des données qui vont encore nourrir de nouveaux modèles.

C'est de cette manière que débute un effondrement des modèles (6): le nouveau mot, qui n'a jusque-là toujours pas davantage de sens qu'auparavant et ne renvoie à rien, se dissémine de modèle en modèle, de *dataset* en *dataset*, jusqu'à être intégré par des *bots* dans leur production de contenus textuels. Le mot *arafed* n'est alors même plus nécessairement en début de phrase. Il est parfois conjugué comme un verbe, parfois utilisé comme adjectif ou encore comme nom propre. Il accompagne des images et des vidéos, décrit des sons ou envahit des documents PDF. Dès lors, à travers des processus d'extraction de données en ligne, il se propage encore davantage dans de nouveaux *datasets* voués à entraîner de nouveaux modèles et continue d'être contextualisé sans qu'un sens ou une définition claire n'apparaissent. *Arafed* est un mot vide qui se reproduit ainsi partout et sans cesse.

Un mot produit par des machines, manipulé par des machines pour des machines, un mot stérile, vain, mais qui ne cesse d'être intégré dans des contextes linguistiques divers, en général dans des ensembles de langue anglaise, mais pas toujours. Dans le réseau mondialisé qui forme nos existences, ce mot se diffuse comme un virus, un artefact linguistique ayant muté de lui-même, parfaitement adapté aux organismes automatiques et auquel nous sommes finalement, nous aussi, exposés.

Virus linguistique, *arafed* semble presque constituer une preuve accidentelle de la théorie de l'internet mort^[7]. Dans un réseau de communication peuplé exclusivement de *bots*, tenter de saisir, de situer le terme *arafed* est un exercice vain, une tentative vouée à l'échec. Pour autant, l'objet du présent dictionnaire est bien d'exploiter les logiciels infectés par le virus *arafed* pour proposer de ce dernier une multitude de définitions plus ou moins irrationnelles.

Dans une perspective accélérationniste pour un effondrement des modèles d'intelligence artificielle, définir ce mot sans substance peut être un jeu aussi puissant qu'amusant : un effort de réappropriation par l'absurde en vue de remplir de nouveaux *dataset* avec du vide pour dérégler les machines. Compiler des définitions du mot *arafed*, comme le propose ce dictionnaire, constitue aussi un processus ludique et poétique d'analyse du langage contemporain, une étude de la liquidité qui caractérise la langue dans le réseau de machines et de la manière dont elle dénote d'une symbiose plus ou moins harmonieuse entre *bots* et culture.

En débutant par l'écriture d'un ordre en langue anglaise, ce dictionnaire s'attache aussi à travailler une écriture opérative pour proposer des interprétations du mot *arafed* produites par différents LLM. Des définitions artificielles pour un mot qui n'a aucun sens, orientées par des instructions bien humaines, un *prompt* qui, en tant qu'introduction au présent ouvrage, a l'avantage de situer son lecteur humain dans le corps d'un ordinateur et de renverser, un peu, nos perspectives anthropocentrées.

Enfin, si la totalité des définitions proposées dans ce dictionnaire ont été produites par des LLM, l'une d'entre elles fait cependant exception. Kühr et Liu, que l'on peut considérer comme les découvreurs du mot *arafed*, se sont en effet risqués à l'exercice lorsqu'un membre de leur auditoire leur a demandé, au cours de leur conférence, une définition du terme. Leur proposition se trouve ici en première place d'une longue liste de productions artificielles et introduit avec une certaine finesse les tentatives suivantes.
